

3/1: ARTimation Media Arts Festival

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Vancouver (February 7, 2008) – Get ready for a full day of mind-blowing, jaw-dropping, heart-racing workshops, demonstrations, activities, competitions and keynote speakers at The Art Institute of Vancouver's ARTimation Media Arts Festival.

Taking place on March 1, 2008 from 11am to 11pm at the Rocky Mountaineer Station in Vancouver, ARTimation will feature the areas of gaming, animation, visual effects, film, and recording arts – all of which are creative programs offered at The Art Institute's Burnaby campus.

With 20,000 square feet of space and 35-foot high ceilings, the expansive venue will be turned into an innovative and interactive area where attendees can spend the day learning about media arts industries through game play, film screenings, production workshops, hands-on drawing tutorials, industry-insider information sessions, and high-profile keynote speakers.

In addition, ARTimation will host three exciting competitions, the Canadian High School Film Festival Competition 2008, Game Concept Competition, and Character Art Competition. All three competitions require that entries are submitted prior to the event with a film entry deadline of February 15 and a game concept and character art entry deadline of February 21. Winners will be announced on event day and the first place winners in each of the six film categories, one game concept winner, and one character art winner will receive cash awards.

Tickets to ARTimation are available at \$10 with pre-registration or \$15 at the door, including complimentary entry for two parents per student.
